## **NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN**

Nominations will be accepted up until **Friday 29 March 2019**. The competition fills very quickly, so it is important to nominate as soon as possible.

*Late nominations will only be accepted in divisions where a vacancy exists.*

### **Divisions available**

- 10/11 years A & B
- 11/12 Years A & B

**Cost** - \$99 per team. Nomination fees do NOT need to accompany nomination forms. Administration fee of \$30 applies if teams are withdrawn after 5 May 2019. Schools will be invoiced after nomination is confirmed. Payment to be made to QCNA on receipt of invoice.

### **Divisions**

- Schools are able to nominate **1 team in division A and 2 in division B** in each age groupings.
- Those schools with a strong netball focus should enter teams in the A division. Schools that are developing netball or introducing should nominate for B division.
- Where possible a limit of 8 teams per division will be allocated.
- To balance out the divisions and draw some teams may need to be changed from the nominated division therefore it is important that the standard of your teams be advised in the nomination submission.
- Late nominations will only be accepted in divisions where a vacancy exists.

**Umpires** - each team entering the competition needs to supply their own badged or competent umpire. Due to previous complaints we ask that you **not have one of your team players umpire**. Please give serious attention to securing an umpire for each team as soon as possible as it can be difficult in getting an umpire for a week day competition.

### **Trophies awarded to school**

Division A – The Perpetual Cup will be awarded to Division A winners and the school retains the cup for 12 months, returning it for the 2020 competition. For all divisions a school trophy for the winners and runners up will be awarded.
